




- ✓ Have a valid DNI or NIE.
- Have at least 30 ECTS of an official MSc Degree program enrolled at the moment of the application and prove you have passed them before the exchange.



Be a UB student next academic year 2022-23 in the degree for which the application has been submitted. This is: formalize your enrolment in the MSc next academic year according to the indications given and before your exchange.



✓ A student going on exchange is a full-time student and so, in the case of master students, they must do at the foreign institution, and have recognized at the UB, between 24 - 30 ECTS for one-semester exchanges.



The minimum can be 15 ECTS in case you have less than 60 ECTS pending to enroll to finish your MSc during the year in which the exchange takes place.




- Exchange students do not have to pay tuition fees at the foreign institution. They may be required to pay small fees for other purposes (material, student unions, etc.).
- Selected students will be responsible for all the costs related to the mobility (accommodation, travel, etc.).




Within the Erasmus+ program, the UB provides selected students with an accidents and repatriation insurance covering the whole exchange period of the Erasmus+ studies. Students are however also responsible for having a valid health insurance covering the entire exchange period.



- Under the Global Faculty program, students are required to take out medical, accident and repatriation insurance with coverage for the duration of their stay.
- Being selected by the UB does not automatically imply that the student is also accepted by the foreign institution.





For mobility at master level, you have to certify the exchange language according to the "Language Accreditation Procedure " of the UB. We recommend you to only select those destinations your level of language corresponds to.


Language requirements

- a) The presentation of the copy of the official certificate, as long as it is included in the CIC Document or the ACLES List.
- b) The presentation of the copy of the enrollment (academic year 2021 2022) of the School of Modern Languages of the UB, which will accredit the previous level of language.
- c) In the case of another document that is not listed in section A or B, it will be possible to consult with the <u>coordinators of the EIM</u> of the UB. The EIM will accredit the student's language skills directly to the study center (without issuing a certificate).
- d) In the case of not having any document included of those included in sections A, B or C, the language skills can be accredited by taking the language exams organized by the EIM of the UB, under the indications and deadlines indicated at: EIM LEVEL TESTS
 FOR INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY PROGRAMS. The EIM will accredit the student's language skills directly to the study center and will also issue an accreditation with the student's level of language proficiency. Registration to tests is now open and is done online through the link provided.

Once you have finished the application, you must submit it through the same platform, with the other documents, if applicable.

If more than one application is submitted, only the last one will be considered valid.


In case your MSc program has also agreements within the framework of the Global Faculty Program, and you want to apply for both programs, you must submit two applications, one for each program.

Application Period

From December 13th to January 12th

Resolution: March 3rd, 2022 Acceptance: March 4th-9th, 2022

You will have to accept the allocated destination in the period indicated to do so, otherwise it will be treated as a resignation.



Group 1 Countries with higher living standards: Denmark Grant of € 310 per month

Group 2

Countries with medium living standards: Germany, France, Italy, **Netherlands**

Grant of € 260 per month



Selected students who have received a general scholarship from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport or a scholarship from the Department of Education of the Basque Country in the 2021-2022 academic year, those who have a recognized disability legally qualified to a degree equal to or greater than 33% or those who prove to have the status of refugee or have the right to subsidiary protection or who have applied for international protection in Spain:

Grant of +250€ per month

Selected students with a recognized and legally qualified disability of 33% or more may apply for the SEPIE call for grants to cover the extraordinary expenses caused by mobility.

Green Travel: single payment of 50€ per sustainable trip to the destination and, if applicable, up to 4 additional scholarship days.



SANTANDER-UB

Sole payment of 200€ in the framework of the Erasmus+ program

Sole payment of 1000€ in the framework of the Global Faculty

program



SANTANDER-ERASMUS Only for the Erasmus+ Program

2 grants consisting in a single payment of 2,000€ (for students with a recognized disability of more than 33%) and 49 grants consisting in a single payment of 500€. This call is now open until de 15th of March, you can find all the information in: Beca Santander-Erasmus: sol·licitud oberta! The application to the grant must be submitted prior to the deadline, although the resolution of the mobility call is not yet published.
