MINUTES OF THE PANEL'S RESOLUTION OF THE 1ST NEUROCONCURS "YOU, YOUR BRAIN AND YOUTUBE" OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BARCELONA

To celebrate that 2012 is the Year of Neuroscience in Spain, the University of Barcelona (UB) organized a short film contest in which everyone was able to participate.

The main goal of the project is to link neuroscience with daily aspects, so videos cannot be based on scientific contents. The aim is to remark the permanent action of the nervous system and the brain in our daily actions as a way to understand their relevance.

The activity is part of the project **NeuroUB: Neuroscience, Music and Art**, funded by the Spanish Foundation for Science and Technology (FECYT) - Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness and the Secretary for Universities and Research from the Ministry of Economy and Knowledge of the Government of Catalonia.

The panel of NeuroConcurs, chaired by Dr Enric Canela, vice-rector for Science Policy of the UB, and composed by Dr Carles Escera, director of the Institute for Brain, Cognition and Behavior of the UB (IR3C) and professor from the Department of Psychiatry and Clinical Psychobiology of the UB; Dr Joan Guàrdia, professor from the Department of Methodology of the Behavioural Sciences of the UB; Ms Irene Romero, project manager of IR3C; Mr Raül Deamo, technician at the Audiovisuals Unit of the UB, and Ms Margarita Becerra, responsible for the Unity of Scientific Culture and Innovation (UCC+i) of the Communication Unit of the UB who acted as secretary, met on 31st May 2013, at 10 a.m., and agreed the following:

1. To confer the best video award on Mar Vilà Duch for *La sinestèsia*.
2. To confer the most original video on Emma Sudrià for *Nictalopia*.
3. To confer the best video made by an under 16 award on sisters Alícia and Clàudia Redrado for *Neurociència*.
4. To confer the most popular video award on Emma Sudrià for *Nictalopia*.
5. To judge very positively all participating videos.
6. To celebrate the award ceremony on 27 June together with NeuroConcerts closing.
