

Position Title: Visiting Assistant Professor

Location: Puebla, Mexico

Job Description: Visiting professor of the Department of Law and Political Science, Tecnológico de Monterrey University, Campus Puebla. Candidates are expected to teach at the undergraduate level, four courses per semester, in English.

Qualifications: Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Law, Political Science, International Relations or closely related fields. Experience related to academic projects in Law, Political Science and International Relations is desirable. Strong teaching interest required. Candidates must have experience implementing innovative, interactive, and inspiring educational strategies and technology in the classroom.
