MASTER'S IN ANALYTIC PHILOSOPHY

To obtain the Master's degree in Analytical Philosophy, students must enrol and pass 60 credits (ECTS) from the following subjects of the master's degree:

 \cdot 15 credits of common compulsory subjects: Metaethics, Models of Justice and Human Rights and Human Rights and Research Methods in Analytical Philosophy.

· 10 credits corresponding to the Master's Thesis (compulsory).

 \cdot 15 specific credits corresponding to the chosen itinerary, i.e. Theoretical Philosophy or Practical Philosophy. These consist of 5 credits from the Research Seminar and 10 credits from Module 5 or Module 6.

 \cdot 20 credits to choose from the range of optional courses on offer.

The optional courses can be chosen from among the subjects in Module 3. Students can apply to register as an optional subject a subject that is compulsory in the other itinerary. Students who do not have the training and competences in philosophy must acquire them before being admitted to the Master's programme. Up to 30 credits are offered in Complementary Training Courses, which provide such training (these are only offered in Spanish or Catalan).
