

Call for Expressions of Interest for hosting MSCA Fellows at Universitat de Barcelona (Department of Economics, Economic Theory Section)

The Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) [Postdoctoral Fellowships](#) (PFs) scheme is now open and the Department of Economics (Economic Theory section) at Universitat de Barcelona is inviting expressions of interests to participate. MSCA fellows will carry out their own research project in collaboration with their supervisor and gain interdisciplinary, inter-sectoral and international experience. The grant usually covers a generous salary for two years, a mobility (and family) allowance and an allocation for research and training costs.

There are two types of Postdoctoral Fellowships:

- *European Fellowships* are held in the EU or associated countries and are open to researchers either coming to Europe or moving within Europe for a period of one to two years.
- *Global Fellowships* fund secondments outside Europe and are addressed to researchers whose Host Organization is based in the EU or associated Countries. Fellows work in a non-associated Third Country for a period of one to two years and must then return to their Host Organization for a period of one year. These fellowships last between two to three years.

Only one proposal per researcher can be submitted to this call.

- A covering letter outlining research synergies (max. 1 page)
- A short summary of the proposed research idea (no more than 2 pages)
