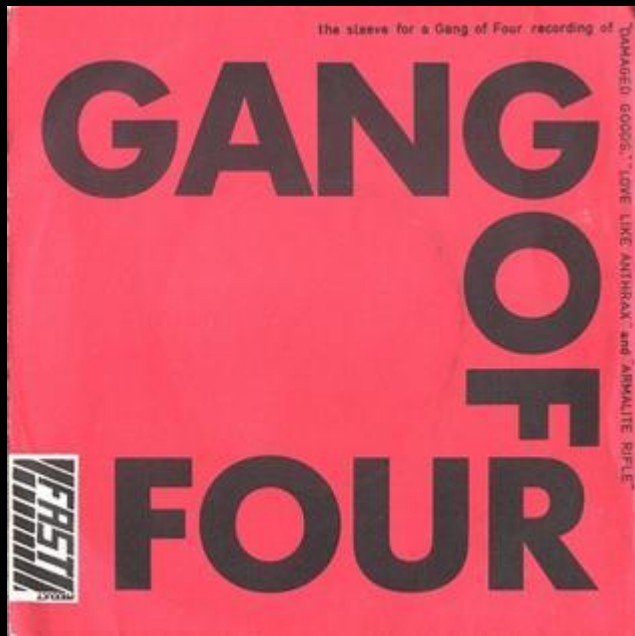


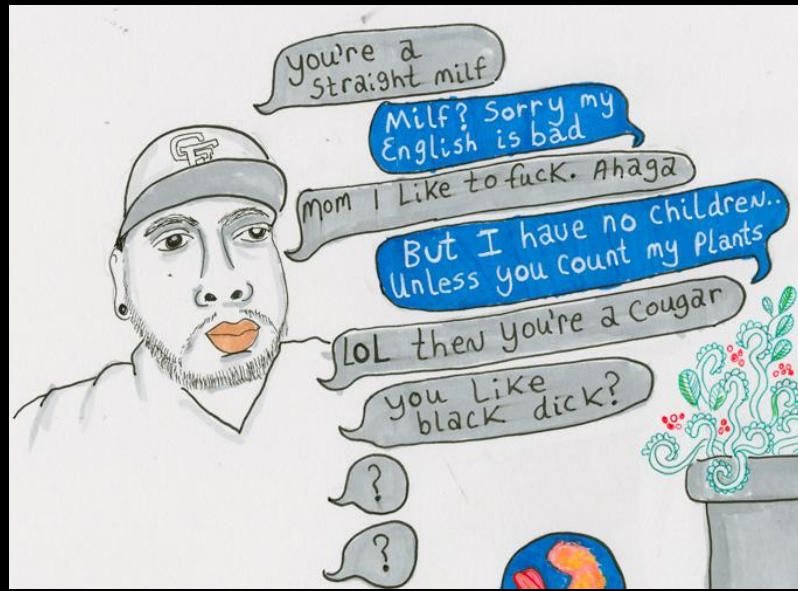
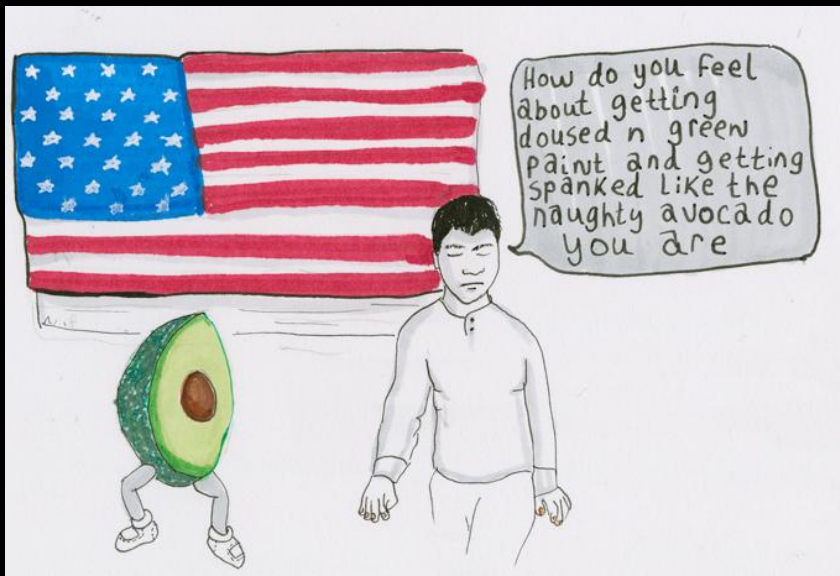
Reproductibilitat. Conceptes
